



St. John divorce suit the petitioner, recalled, gave a denial to the allegations against her.

TUESDAY, DEC. 15. Thirty lives were lost by the wreck of the British sailing-ship Enterkin on the Galloper Sands, off Ramsgate, during the gale on Saturday night.

Mr. Arnold Morley, M.P., spoke at Street last evening in support of the candidature of his brother, Mr. Charles Morley, for East Somerset. He criticised the position of the Dis-sentients, saying that the only sacrifice they had made was that of principle.

Mr. Labouchere, writing to a Dundee correspondent with regard to labour candidates, recommends that the question of labour representation should not be pushed at the forthcoming general election, but that all should go for throwing election expenses on the rates and payment of members, with a second ballot where necessary.

Sir Edward Clarke, the Solicitor-General, has written a letter strongly in favour of the repeal of the bye-law which has led to the disturbances at Eastbourne.

The twelfth exhibition of Truth toys, which this year number 22,000, is being arranged in the Polytechnic, Regent-street, and will be open to the public to-morrow and on Thursday.

There was a small supply of cattle at the Islington Christmas market yesterday as compared with recent years. There was no falling off in excellence of quality however. On the whole prices were slightly below those of last year.

We learn from Sofia that the expulsion of a French newspaper correspondent based on the rupture of diplomatic relations between France and Bulgaria.

Father Ohrwalder and two sisters of the Austrian Soudan Mission, who were taken prisoners in Kordofan, in 1883, and have since been detained by the Mahdi and the Khalifa, have just arrived safely at Korosko, on the Nile.

After a hearing which extended over seven sittings, a verdict was returned in the Florence St. John divorce suit yesterday. The jury found that Mr. Maris, the respondent, had been guilty of adultery with Marie Luella, but not guilty of cruelty towards the petitioner.

At the close of an inquest at Kensington last evening Mr. Hicks, the coroner, commented in strong terms on the common practice of undertakers in receiving the bodies of still-born children.

Mr. Justice Mathew gave judgment in the Chancery Division in the remarkable case of Anastapha v. Wedlake. Mr. Anastapha, an Egyptian by birth, died suddenly at his residence near the Finsbury Park, about two years ago, leaving three children.
