APROPOS OF THE CHILIAN DIFFICULTY.

The difficulty between the United States of North America and the Republic of Chile is at present one of great interest, even in the pre-occupied River Plate. A French medical journal has arrived at the conclusion that the sunual mortality of the entire human race amounts, roughly speaking, to thirty three millions of persons. 
