

Chitral had been literally fulfilled. It was characteristic of the whole policy that the military element had captured the Government of India.

The County Council sat yesterday to consider the recommendations of the Licensing Committee with regard to buildings used for music, dancing, and stage plays. In only one instance was the recommendation of the Committee opposed. This related to the Hans Crescent Hotel, Chelsea. The Committee proposed to refuse the licence, which had been opposed by residents on the ground of annoyance caused by entertainments given at the Cadogan Rooms. The question was debated by the Council, and an amendment to the effect that the licence should be granted, on a certain condition, was adopted.

The London School Board Election has resulted in a complete victory for Education, and a crushing defeat for Mr. Diggle and his party. Mr. Diggle himself has been rejected in Marylebone. For the Progressive candidates, who have secured a complete working majority on the Board, 572,664 votes were cast, their Moderate opponents obtaining 426, 893. The new Board is composed of 29 Progressives (30 if the Labour candidate be counted), 24 Denominationalists, and two Roman Catholics.

Yesterday afternoon the Conference between the Employers' Federation and the Allied Trades was resumed at the Westminster Palace Hotel. At the conclusion of the day's proceedings, Mr. Biggart stated that the men had provisionally accepted the employers' modified definition of freedom of management. This definition, it is stated, excludes of normal hours, and general rises and falls in wages, what conditions prevailed in one federated shop when the dispute began, may be introduced into another federated shop at the option of the employer concerned. The conference will be resumed on Tuesday.

Mr. Stoddart's team commenced their match with Queensland at Brisbane yesterday. The visitors won the toss, and were batting all day. At the close of play they had made 333 for the loss of four wickets. Mr. Mason scoring 74.

Before Mr. Justice Darling, at the Central Criminal Court, yesterday, the case of James Harris, charged with the wilful murder of his wife, and also with attempted suicide, was heard. The peculiarity of the case was the fact that the prisoner, in consequence of the alleged attempted suicide, had lost the use of his voice, he only being able to whisper intermittently, a state of things complicated by his inability to read or write. The question was raised whether he ought to be put on his trial. The jury found that the prisoner was capable of pleading but incapable of instructing his solicitor for his defence. Harris, in reply to the usual question as to whether he was guilty, pleaded "No in a whisper." The plea was recorded, and the trial postponed till next Sessions.

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 29.

The Kaiser's new Naval Bill asks for the building of new vessels costing over 8,000,000, during the next seven years. The total expenditure on the navy for the same period a Berlin Correspondent estimates at twenty-five millions.

Yesterday the Emperor Francis Joseph addressed a letter to Count Badeni, the Austrian Premier, decreeing the adjournment of the Reichsrath until further orders. The Cabinet has resigned and a new one is to be formed by Baron Gausch, the Minister of Instruction. On Saturday pandemonium again reigned in the Reichsrath, and the President was obliged to suspend the sitting. Yesterday disorder prevailed in the streets of Vienna until it was known that the Ministry had resigned.

A meeting of the Progressive members of the new London School Board was held on Saturday, at which it was resolved to offer the Chairmanship of the Board to Lord Reay, the Vice-chairman going to Mr. E. Lylich Stanley.

Mr. Diggle has issued an address to the electors of Marylebone, in which he declares that the recent election resulted in the victory of organized forces over unorganized effort paralysed by sectional intrigues. The Moderate party was deprived of organized political support, and left to rely solely upon unorganized popular sympathy. Consequently the public mind was confused, undecided, and therefore inactive. Personally, he adds, he is now free to accept in another sphere public work which he has hitherto been precluded from accepting.

Letters of administration of the personal estate and effects of the late Duchess of Teck have been granted, the value being sworn at 30,471, gross.

The death of Sir George Tyler, Alderman of the Ward of Queenhithe, who filled the office of Lord Mayor of London four years ago, is announced. It was during his majority that the Tower Bridge was opened.

A severe gale was experienced in many parts of the country yesterday. Collisions are reported to have occurred in the English and Bristol Channels. It is feared that considerable loss of life occurred off Lundy, where a steamer was sunk, and a portion only of her crew rescued. A boat in which the captain and four men put off is still missing. At Blackpool Nelson's oil vessel, the Foudroyant, was broken up by the force of the waves, nothing

being left but the stern. Thousands of people assembled and carried off as souvenirs wreckage east on the shore.

The match between Mr. Stoddart's team and thirteen of Queensland and New South Wales was continued at Brisbane on Saturday. The English innings closed for the large total of 636. Druce made 126 and McLaren 181. At the drawing of stumps for the day the Colonials had lost two wickets for 39.

In the Football League Championship on Saturday Aston Villa won another match, and as the course of the days play turned this much strengthened their position next to Sheffield United, who are strongly at the head of affairs. Everton, Sheffield Wednesday, Liverpool, and Wolverhampton Wanderers were the other successful teams. Sheffield United had no fixture in the League, but instead they sent a side to London for a game with the Corinthians, by whom they were somewhat easily beaten by two goals to none. In the Rugby game Lancashire won a county championship match, and Blackheath beat Richmond. Both Universities were successful, Oxford defeating the Edinburgh Academicals and Cambridge the London Scottish.

In the Court for the Consideration of Crown Cases Reserved on Saturday judgment was given in a case, stated by the Recorder of Worcester, who had sentenced a man for entering a restaurant and ordering and eating a meal for which he had no money to pay. The Court held that the jury were justified in finding, that when he ordered the goods and when he consumed them he had no intention of paying, and that he intended to cheat and was guilty of fraud. Under these circumstances they thought the conviction was valid and must be affirmed.

Judgment was given in the Chancery Division on Saturday, in the case in which Mr. Labouchere M. P., sought an injunction against Mr. Hess, proprietor of the "African Critic," and Mrs. Sala, to restrain them from publishing, divulging, or parting with certain letters written by him to the late Mr. G. A. Sala. As regards Mr. Hess Mr. Justice North made the order asked for, though in amended terms—cost following the event. As to Mrs. Sala, he thought she should publish the letters of her late husband, in a book she said she was about to put forth. So far as she was concerned the present action would be dismissed.
