Then she waited and waited anxiously, expecting to hear from him again; and the days dawned, and soared to their height, and dropped down wearily into the west, one after the other, slowly, monotonously; until a month, two months, nearly three were past, and, at length, one morning an aged neighbour called in to see Mr. Bingle, and, having ascertained that Mary was gone, opened a newspaper with a forlorn and serious air, and proceeded, after some few words of preface, to read out a paragraph which briefly stated that the Cormorant, the vessel in which John had sailed, had gone down in a storm in mid-ocean, and that all on board had perished.
