"We read in the B. A. Standard.—The many friends of Captain C. M. Chester, of the Cincinnati, and Commander R. M. Todd, and that the squadron, of which Captain Chester is senior officer, was at Kingston, Jamaica, just south of the Island of Cuba, on Monday, where the ships were coaling.

Telegraphic reports come from Shanghai that serious disturbances have taken place in Chi-Kiang. The building in which the North American Mission is located has been destroyed and a student who was on the premises was assassinated. It is said that other persons were murdered by the mutineers. The assassins were arrested, but the militia (?) refused to allow them to be executed and the authorities declare that they are powerless to enforce compliance with their orders.

Armadale, the accomplice of Danby in the fraud on the British Bank, says that all he got from Danby was five hundred pounds. Armadale got married in England and then deserted his wife after taking all her valuables and jewellery. That wife is now coming out to prosecute him. It is also reported that he is married to an Australian lady, who is also coming to settle accounts with him.

LONDON NOTES

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 25.

To-day the Queen will hold the first Drawing Room of the present season at Buckingham Palace. Accompanied by Princess Henry of Battenberg, her Majesty left Windsor for London yesterday morning. On her passage through the streets of the West End from Paddington to Green Park she was loudly cheered. Soon after one in the afternoon her Majesty drove to Westminster to view the statue of Boadicea on the northern side of the bridge. In the evening a small dinner party was given at the Palace.

Replying in questions addressed to him in the House of Lords yesterday, Lord Salisbury made important statements as to Greece and Turkey, and as to events in West Africa. On the latter point he read a telegram from Sir E. Monson in Paris confirming the declaration that no French troops had entered Sokoto or Argungu. As to the former he announced that as soon as the Greek loan, which had been jointly guaranteed by England, Russia, and France, was offered on the market, the liability of the Sultan of Turkey to evacuate Thessaly would have begun.

More than eighty questions were addressed to Ministers in the House of Commons, a query being raised by Mr. MacNeill as to why the Prince Minister's statement on West African matters on Tuesday had not been communicated to the Lower Chamber. Mr. Curzon replied that the late arrival of Lord Salisbury's train in that day, coupled with the count-out in the House itself, had prevented him reading the telegram on the adjournment. A statement was also made by Mr. Curzon as to Russia's pledge to maintain open ports on the coast of China. On a motion for adjournment, language employed by the Crown Prosecutor at the Westport Court House on Thursday last was discussed. Afterwards in Committee of Supply, Mr. Chamberlain spoke on the Government policy in West Africa, Ho

urged the necessity of maintaining an adequate frontier force, and added that he believed the whole country was at their back in their determination to exhibit a conciliatory disposition, but not to allow the important interests of this country to be sacrificed. A motion to reduce the vote was rejected by 234 to 27.

In special interviews with M. Zola and Maître Labori upon the results of the trial and the prospects of the Dreyfus agitation, M. Zola said that he had no grief on his own account, but that he was stricken to the soul to find France so blind to truth as to make such a verdict possible. His sorrow was for Dreyfus and for France.

In the French Chamber yesterday, the Government was interpellated on the attitude of the Generals at the Assize Court during the Zola trial. M. Méline replied, defending the officers. They had received no orders from the Government, and although General de Boisdeffre had gone further than was warranted in threatening to resign, he had received great provocation. The Premier declared that the Dreyfus agitation must now cease, and that the Government would act to that end with energy and promptitude in the application of the powers placed in its hands. A vote on an Order of the Day gave the Cabinet an over-whelming majority.

Sir John Evans presided last evening over a meeting of the Royal Society, at which Dr. Murray, of the Challenger Expedition, read a paper advocating the sending out of an expedition to explore the Antarctic. Dr. Nansen, Sir Joseph Hooker, Professor Neumayer, Sir Clements Markham, Sir Archibald Geikie, and others urged the scientific advantages to be derived from such exploration.

The Board of Trade inquiry into the loss of the steamer Channel Queen concluded at Plymouth yesterday. The court found the master and chief mate both in default, and imperatively recommended that a light and fog signal should be placed on the Braes Rocks where the vessel struck.

Mr. Wynne F. Baxter yesterday resumed the inquiry, at Whitechapel, as to the deaths of the two victims of the tragedy which occurred at 115, Brick-lane, Spital-fields, on the 5th. Frederick Karaczewski, the prisoner who is charged with murder, was again in court in the custody of two warders from Holloway Gaol. After hearing the evidence of the injured woman Kawoska, who declared that Wysocka had arranged to have the prisoner thrown downstairs by "the boys," the jury returned a verdict of manslaughter in the case of Kuczmicrowich and of accidental death in the case of Wysocka.

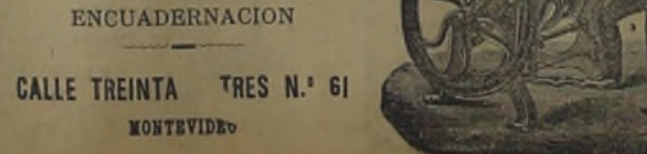
