Upon the House of Commons resolving itself into Committee of Ways and Means, the First Commissioner of Works gave details of an elaborate scheme for providing new public offices, necessitating an expenditure of two-and-a-half millions.

Evidence was given yesterday to the House of Commons' Committee on Money Lending by Mr. Shucksbury, who traded at Bristol and Exeter under the name of the Clerical and Medical Bank.

A Correspondent, telegraphing from Kenur yesterday, states that the Dervishes continue their advance towards the Atbara, and that patrols have already been seen on the river.

The Australian Federal Convention held its final sitting at Melbourne yesterday. Speeches generally eulogistic of the Federation Bill were delivered, and the Session closed with cheers for the Queen.

The Imperial German Consul-General, Baron Von Lindeloff, presided last evening at the annual dinner of the German Society of Benevolence, the subscriptions in aid of the Charity amounting to 1276l.

It is officially announced that Mr. Cosmo Bonser, M.P., has been appointed Chairman of the South Eastern Railway Company in place of the late Sir George Russell, M.P., and that the Hon. Gathorne Hardy has been elected Vice-Chairman of the Company.

To commemorate the services of the late General Moberly it was decided at yesterday's meeting of the School Board for London that the Harrow-road school should in future be known as the Moberly school.

Scenes of extraordinary enthusiasm were witnessed yesterday both inside and outside Drury Lane Theatre on the occasion of Miss Nellie Farren's benefit. From ten or eleven o'clock the previous night crowds began to assemble outside the gallery entrance, and directly the doors were opened in the morning the theatre was filled to overflowing.

News of the decease of Mr. Aubrey Beardsley has been received from Montevideo, the immediate cause of death being hemorrhage of the lungs.

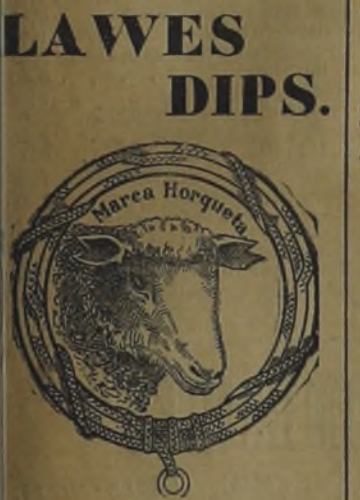

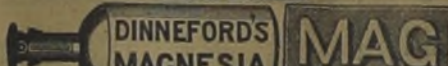
