LONDON NOTES

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 23.

During a half hour's sitting of the House of Lords yesterday the Special Juries Bill passed through Committee, and the Registration (Ireland) Bill was read a second time. A statement was made by the Earl of Selborne as to the French occupation of Boussa and Nikki.

Business was rapidly dispatched in the House of Commons, and when the sitting was adjourned just before half past seven the paper had been cleared, the Irish Surnames Bill being the last measure dealt with. Prior to this the Distress in Ireland was discussed on the Consolidated Fund (No. 1) Bill, and debate had taken place on the relative merits of the Scotch and English Education Codes, and the Control of Parochial Charities.

Mr. Justice Mathew gave evidence yesterday to the House of Commons Committee on Money Lending. He was strongly of opinion that Parliament should intervene to save the borrower from usurious extortion. Evidence was also given on co-operative banks, and on a suggested alteration of the law in India.

Under the presidency of Dr. Spence Watson, the Annual Conference of the National Liberal Federation was opened at Leicester yesterday, the attendance of delegates being the largest known for years. In moving the adoption of the report, the Chairman reminded his hearers that the organization came of age that day, and said he was satisfied that never at any previous period of its existence had it occupied a more useful position than it did at the present time. Many things in the report gave them cause for great hope and thankfulness.

Mr. and Mrs. Gladstone and party travelled from Bournemouth to Hawarden yesterday, by way of Basingstoke and Oxford, their home in Flintshire being reached shortly before eight in the evening. Mr. Gladstone bore the fatigues of the journey well. As the train was leaving the Southern watering-place the right hon. gentleman, addressing the crowd which had gathered to see him off, said: "God bless you all, and this place, and the land you love."

In the Italian Chamber yesterday the debate began on the report of the Committee charged with the investigation of Signor Crispi's relations with the Bank of Naples. It early became evident that there was a majority hostile to the ex-Premier. In the end, however, the debate was adjourned.

There was yesterday a revival of the war scare at Washington, due in great measure to a statement that Mr. McKinley realised that he was no longer in a position to control events with regard to Cuba. A correspondent is able, however, to affirm that the President has not changed his attitude, and that he is as anxious as ever to avoid war. Evidence of the terrible sufferings of the non-combatants in Cuba has, on the other hand, convinced him more deeply than ever that intervention in their behalf is inevitable. The only remedy, in his opinion, is to inform the Spanish Government, in as conciliatory a manner as possible, that the sufferers must be returned to their homes and the conditions of civilized warfare restored. Such an intimation the President would not regard as an act of war, and if Spain should treat it as a hostile measure her action, in his opinion, would remain to be justified by her in the eyes of the world.

A telegram received at Shanghai from Ching-King states that the local militia are opposing the execution of the murderer of the native medical assistant at the

American Mission there. The Consuls have called upon the Tuotai to carry out the sentence, to arrest the leaders of the rioters, and to afford protection to the Mission.

Sir Albert Rolitt presided over the annual dinner of the London Chamber of Commerce, which took place at the Hotel Cecil last evening. The principal speakers were Lord Charles Beresford for the Navy, Mr. Asquith for the House of Commons, who pointed out that in these times of disquietude and anxiety abroad it was necessary to withhold criticism and suspend inquiry; and the President of the Board of Trade, who declared that the Government policy in relation to other countries was not aggressive, but aimed only at the maintenance of commercial rights.

Two largely-attended meetings were held yesterday at the Mansion House and the Queen's Hall to inaugurate the centenary year of the Religious Tract Society. A letter was received from the Queen, announcing that her Majesty was pleased to become Patron of the Society, and it was stated that over 30,000 had been received to commence a Centenary Fund. Among the speakers at the meetings were the Archbishop of Canterbury, the Bishop of London, Dr. A. K. H. Boyd, Mr. Bryce, M. P., Dr. C. A. Berry, and Dr. Oswald Dykes.

The match between Mr. Stoddart's team and the South Australia Eleven was continued at Adelaide yesterday. Wainwright, and Mason gave a fine display of cricket, and made 105 and 84 respectively. At the close of play the score was 348 for five wickets.
