We read in a London paper of recent date.—The Yellow and other journals in the United States are threatened with a famine of white paper. The supply has given out owing to the extraordinary production of «extras» on the war. The public taste has simply run riot on this succulent luxury. One paper, we are told, has given full accounts of the battle of Manila, which are a long way ahead of Commodore Dewey's dispatches. Another prints daily articles dated from the flag-ship New York in spite of the fact that all correspondents were compelled to leave the vessel a week ago. The Government should establish paper «granaries», or there may be no means of publishing the news when it really comes to hand. But after all, the American Press has enterprise enough to overcome this or any other difficulty for itself. It has been generally supposed that there is but one cable to the Philippines. This seems to be an error. The «World» has apparently succeeded in establishing communication of its own «via France». And all since the battle of last Sunday! If fiction discoloured the paper on which it was printed, motley would be the only wear in some parts of the Union just now.

LONDON NOTES

FRIDAY, MAY 6.

A Washington Correspondent says the President has decided that the exigencies of the war make necessary the annexation of Hawaii. He has already made known his opinion to leading Senators and members of the Lower House and submitted to them his plans in connection with the islands. It is believed that both Houses will adopt them without serious opposition.

Yesterday the tug Leyden returned to Key West from Cuba, having successfully landed scouts and ammunition for the insurgents. The movement was protected by the fire of the gunboat Wilmington, and a force of Spanish cavalry and infantry who tried to oppose it were several times repulsed.

A Correspondent in Madrid, in reporting further disturbances in various parts of Spain, says that the misery has been increased by the action of foreign speculators, who, although not enough grain is grown to supply the needs of the population, have taken advantage of the fall in the peseta to export corn. The Chamber yesterday adopted the Government Bill suspending in certain cases the import duties on grain, and prohibiting export until the 15th August.

The Cuban autonomous Parliament was opened by Marshal Blanco at Havana yesterday. The Governor delivered a patriotic speech calling upon his hearers to swear to die for the defence of Spain.

At Freetown (Sierra Leone) yesterday the Governor's Council passed an ordinance establishing a volunteer force to defend the Colony. It is reported that Rotifunk has been destroyed by the insurgents, and that the American missionaries have been murdered.

On the motion of Lord Herschell the House of Lords yesterday appointed a Select Committee to consider the Copyright Bill. The Lunacy Bill and the Parish Churches (Scotland) Bill were read a second time.

By a majority of 119 the House of Commons rejected the second reading of the Westminster Bridge and Embankment Tramways Bill. Mr. Chamberlain stated, in reply to Mr. Davitt, that recent events in Sierra Leone pointed rather to a general rising against white rule than to the special cause of the hut tax. Mr. Balfour announced that the report of the Committee on Old Age Pensions would be presented in about a fortnight. The Committee stage of the Irish Local Government Bill was again proceeded with.

Mr. F. Belsey, speaking last night at the 95th anniversary of the Sunday School Union at Exeter Hall, said that two or three steamer loads of delegates from America were expected at the third World's Sunday School Convention in July, and in spite of the war the Committee had not heard that they were not coming. Statistics showed that over two millions of teachers and scholars were now affiliated with the Union.

Little more than an hour's cricket was possible at Lord's yesterday, but in that time, on a treacherous wicket, the M. C. C. bowlers got rid of Sussex for the paltry total of 61. Rain also interfered with the matches arranged at Oxford and Cambridge.

Lord Hawks, captain of the Yorkshire County Eleven, yesterday made an important suggestion as to the proposed visit of an Aus-

Italian team of cricketers next year. Test matches between England and the Colonials should, he held, be undertaken by the Cricket Associations of Australia on the one hand, and the Marylebone Club on the other. At home the M.C.C. should select the teams, and not allow the Oval and Manchester to take over the matches.

Arguments were commenced in the House of Lords yesterday in an appeal, under the title of Powell v Kempton Park Racecourse Company, which raised the whole question of what is «a place» within the meaning of the Betting Act of 1853. The appellant is a shareholder of the defendant company. As conflicting decisions had been given by the Queen's Bench and the Court of Appeal on the point at issue, the matter was now carried to the highest judicial body in the country. Mr Asquith had not concluded his arguments for the appellant when their lordships adjourned.
