SUNDRIES.

There being nothing political worth reporting outside the topic of the mutiny, we suppress our usual Political Notes, for today. Yesterday the President was chiefly occupied in receiving visits of congratulation, the number of which was overwhelming. The Caridad Lottery which was suspended on Monday will be played today instead. The races at Maroñas on Sunday last were suspended on account of the bad state of the course (some say on account of the football match, football of late proving a formidable competitor in popularity to horse-racing) and will be held next Sunday instead. The marriage of Miss Margarita Ungo to Mr. Juan Christopherson, postponed on account of the prolonged illness of the latter, will be celebrated at the Lourdes Church at 9 p. m. on Saturday evening. I heard a little story the other evening that has a moral for those of my cycling readers who swear by the cyclist. My hero is a bicycle enthusiast; he is also fond of a game of cards. One night recently he started out for a long ride, his wife seeing that everything was in apple-pie order. She did more. She carefully note the figures shown on the indicator. Some time after daybreak my hero reached home. He had wonderful stories to tell of the delights of this long ride. But he wasn't fatigued, and appeared at breakfast looking tolerably fresh. Meanwhile the wife had consulted the ruthless cyclist. She craftily and sweetly asked, 'How far did you ride, dear?' 'Oh, I don't know; probably about sixty miles.' Then the storm broke. The victim of machinery swore, and incidentally smashed the vigilant monitor of his movements. There is no room in that home for the inventor of the cyclist.

A monstrous crime was committed about 7.30 on Monday night, at the residence of the late Cordero, aged 16, employed in a draper's shop there, had crossed the street to the almacen to buy a packet of cigarettes, and was returning when a revolver shot was heard behind him, and he dropped down dead, shot through the heart. The owner of the almacen and his shop assistant have been arrested, it being believed that the latter is the criminal, though no motive is known for so dastardly a crime. There was hardly anyone about at the time.

LONDON NOTES

TUESDAY, JUNE 7. The bombardment of the Santiago forts by the Americans is said to have recommenced on Saturday night. A telegram received in Madrid direct states that the batteries did not reply, the enemy's vessels being too far off to do any damage. A correspondent at Madrid states that the Government has decided to make representations to the Powers, pointing out that the blockade of Cuba is not effective. Marshal Blanco telegraphs that he is able to receive war material, provisions, and dispatches in spite of the patrolling of the coast by an American vessels. A telegram from Gibraltar says that the squadron under Admiral Camara, which was reported several days ago to have left Cadiz for Cuba, has returned there after manoeuvring at sea. Information received in Vienna is to the effect that the vessels are not yet properly equipped for a voyage across the Atlantic, and that it must be some time before they can definitely put to sea. News has been brought to Hong Kong from Manila by H. M. gunboat Swift, to the effect that fighting is frequent between the Spaniards and the rebels, and that the former have sustained some serious reverses. The rebels have cut the railway outside the town and advanced to within four miles of it. One thousand Spanish prisoners have been taken to Cavite by the rebels who are being assisted by the Americans. Thessaly is again in the hands of the Greeks. The army yesterday reoccupied Tyrnavos and Volo, the last points held by the Turks.

Yesterday the House of Commons met for the first time after the Whitsuntide holidays, but there was only a comparatively small attendance of members. Mr. Balfour informed Mr. H. Lewis that the Government's Secondary Education Bill would be introduced by the Duke of Devonshire in the House of Lords. Replying to Sir William Harcourt, the Leader of the House gave an outline of the proposed course of business during the next few days. Friday would be reserved for the Foreign

Office vote. A motion taking Tuesdays and Wednesdays for Government business for the past, of the morrow and tomorrow (week) was carried by 208 to 63. The second reading of the Finance Bill was carried after a discussion in which a multiplicity of subjects covered by the Budget proposals were canvassed.

Serious rioting took place yesterday in Belfast in connection with processions in celebration of 98 Squadrons of the Inniskilling Dragoons and a number of the North Staffordshire Regiment had to be called out. Many policemen were badly injured, and several men's lives are despaired on. In the course of the melee police and military, both horse and foot, charged and chased the mob, and prisoners; to the number of close on fifty, were conveyed to the barracks. Up to midnight order had not been restored, and affairs were assuming a still more threatening appearance.

Owing to heavy rain at Bradford yesterday it was decided to postpone play in the match between Yorkshire and Surrey. At Lord's it was impossible to make a start in the game between Middlesex and Nottingham until late in the afternoon, and in the three hours that remained for play the visitors scored 150 for the loss of half their men. Mason, the Kent captain, was seen to great advantage at Gravesend. All the Gloucestershire bowlers seemed to suit him and out of the 265 scored for the loss of two wickets he hit up 152 and was still not out.

Mr. Justice Hawkins yesterday summed up the evidence against Walter Horsford, the Huntingdon farmer who was charged with the murder of his cousin, Mrs. Annie Holmes. The jury, after a short deliberation, returned a verdict of guilty, and sentence of death was passed, the Judge remarking that he entirely agreed with the verdict. In his judgment the prisoner had been guilty of a cruel and treacherous murder.

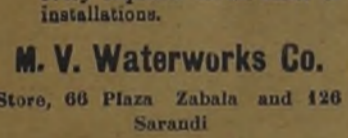
