good cattle and better farming results. Concluding his primary visitation at Croydon, yesterday, the Archbishop of Canterbury delivered an address on the jurisdiction and power of a bishop. His Grace explained that this power was of a twofold nature—that conferred upon him by the law of the Church, and that which he could wield through the machinery of the State. There could be no doubt that proceedings in the courts were very ill suited to bring about a healthy obedience to the law of the Church. Ministers should, he thought, be led by their natural leaders—the Bishops of their dioceses.

A heavy gale sprang up in the Channel last night, during which an exciting scene was witnessed at Dover, some men being rescued with difficulty from a municipal barge, which was ultimately wrecked. Reports from Ireland show that floods of a very serious character visited the southern and south western districts. Parts of Skibbereen, Tralee, and other towns were under water, and on the Bandon railway a train was washed off the rails and ran into a bog. Mr. Fenwick, at Marlborough street Police court yesterday, passed judgment on the persons arrested in connection with the New Pelican club raid. Roth, manager of the premises, was ordered to pay a fine of 300l. or go to prison for three months. Men named Hockley and Sanders were each fined 5l. with the alternative of six weeks imprisonment. Other defendants had to enter into their own recognisances in the sum of 50l. to be of good behaviour for six months.

Frederick Tomlinson, against whom several charges of attempts to wreck trains are being brought, was before the Wellingborough magistrates yesterday charged with placing an obstruction on the Midland Railway on the night of September 9. Police evidence was given that prisoner was under arrest for theft and when charged with this offence said, "I cannot understand your charging me with an offence I am guilty of, and giving me into custody on a charge I am not guilty of; but I am very pleased no one was killed." He was committed for trial.

MONDAY, OCTOBER 17. The Sultan has submitted to the Powers, and ordered the complete withdrawal of the Turkish troops in Crete. The execution will begin on Wednesday.

The German Emperor and Empress are expected to arrive at Constantinople to-day on board the yacht Hohenzollern. Extraordinary precautions are being taken to ensure the safety of their Majesties. Italians without employment are being expelled, and the Government has ordered out a whole class of reserves, and is drafting them into the country adjoining the railway line to Ismid, by which the Emperor is to travel. The Sultan is personally supervising the preparations being made at the Palace for the reception of his Imperial guest.

An impressive ceremony marked the funeral of the Queen of Denmark at the Cathedral of Roskilde on Saturday. The King travelled from Copenhagen accompanied by the Princess of Wales, the Czar and Dowager Empress of Russia, the Crown Prince, and other members of the Danish Royal Family. The service was in addition attended by many special representatives of foreign Courts, the members of the Diplomatic Body, the Danish Ministers, and numerous high officials.

Memorial services were held in this country, that in the German Chapel Royal, St. James's, being attended by the Corps Diplomatique and several members of the Royal Family. A short but impressive sermon was preached by the Rev. A. V. Storm, Danish Chaplain. Services were also held at Balmoral and Sandringham.

This week Sir Anthony P. Macdonnell, Lieutenant Governor of the North West Provinces of India, will leave England to resume his duties. On Saturday he was entertained at dinner at the Hotel Metropole, many of those present being collegiate friends and fellow-countrymen of the distinguished administrator. In a speech acknowledging the hearty good wishes expressed towards him, Sir Anthony referred to the part Irishmen had borne in the development and government of the Empire.

Louise Michel lectured yesterday at the Athenaeum Hall, Tottenham-court-road. Her subject was "The Situation in France," which she depicted in the gloomiest colours. The great power in France was the Army, which was ensconced by discipline. But other institutions were equally hopeless. She urged the necessity of a strong fight being made for the realisation of the dream of true liberty.
