As soon as the U. S. Congress reassembles, the Government will present a Bill for raising the standing army of the United States to 100,000 men.

Yesterday's telegrams adhere to the statement that Spain has decided to give way to the United States on the question of the Philippines, though official confirmation is still lacking.

LONDON NOTES

Major Marchand's report was received yesterday in Paris. According to a semi-official statement it contains no mention of events at Fashoda, but deals merely with the progress of the mission down to September. Captain Barater left Egypt yesterday for Paris, the Siridar being on the same steamer.

By a Royal warrant promulgated to the Army her Majesty has formed a new section of the first class army reserve. It will be composed of reservists of the Royal Artillery, Foot Guards, Infantry of the Line, Army Service Corps, and Royal Army Medical Corps, and will not exceed 5,000 men in strength.

Yesterday being the anniversary of the Battle of Trafalgar, crowds of sightseers, though not so many as in past years, visited Trafalgar square to see the Nelson monument, decorated by the Navy League the adornment, which consisted largely of laurel leaves and other evergreens, was more elaborate than before.

Speeches couched in somewhat similar language were delivered by Mr. Jackson, at Leeds, and Mr. Walter Long at St. Andrew's. Sir W. H. White the new President of the Institution of Junior Engineers, delivered his inaugural address last evening at the Westminster Palace Hotel.

The evidence showed that the deceased had received 'Christian Scientist' treatment, which consisted in reliance on God. The patient was permitted to smoke as much as he liked, and to drink champagne and whisky, though the doctors who had previously attended him had prescribed a dietary in which intoxicants were limited.
