Spain was submitted. The United States Commissioners contented themselves with presenting a long memorandum in English, which they laid on the table with excuses for its length and for its not being translated. They then withdrew, asking that the next sitting should be held on Saturday. The Americans persist in refusing to take over the debt of Cuba, and they demand the cession of the Philippines. The Spaniards on their part refuse to cede that Archipelago.

It is stated that among the papers seized at the apartment of Major Esterhazy, there has been found a letter written on tracing paper identical with that on which the bordereau was written, and bearing a date anterior to that of the bordereau.

Probate of the will of the late Mr. J. J. Colman has been granted, the estate having been valued at 687,024.

In yesterday's football the chief event was the county championship match at Richmond. Middlesex beat the Midland counties by a goal and two tries to nothing. Oxford University were defeated by Devonport Albion by two tries to a goal.

Miss Kate Lyon and Mrs. Athalia Mills were yesterday formally charged, at the Surrey County Police court, at Croydon, with feloniously killing and slaying the late Mr. Harold Frederic, by neglecting to provide him with proper treatment and medical attendance. After evidence of arrest the defendants were remanded on bail until Wednesday next.

William Pearson, who describes himself as a wine and spirit merchant, and resides at Gunnersbury, was at Bath yesterday committed for trial on charges of fraud in connection with a business carried on by him at Bath, under the style of Alexander Baring and Co's Co-operative System of Successful Stock Exchange Dealing.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 11. A New York Correspondent telegraphs that the Western States have now changed the balance of the elections in favour of the Republicans, the result showing that in the West the Imperialistic sentiment is much more strongly developed than elsewhere. The Republicans will have a sure majority between 10 and 20 in the Lower House, and thus hold both Chambers of the Legislature.

The Emperor William arrived at Baalbeck yesterday, and visited the ruins. A marble slab bearing an inscription commemorating the German Monarch's visit was unveiled in the Temple of the Sun.

A serious duel was fought in Vienna yesterday between Herr Wolf, the German Nationalist Deputy to the Reichsrath, and a Polish member. The latter, though severely wounded, refused to lower his weapon, and did so only upon the seconds rushing forward to intervene.

The trial took place at Geneva yesterday of the Anarchist Luciano, for the murder of the Empress Elizabeth. The prisoner, who maintained throughout the defiant attitude, was found guilty, and sentenced to imprisonment for life.

Speaking at Acton last night, Lord George Hamilton referred to the controversy which had arisen between this country and France. He was not, he said, sorry that it had occurred, because he believed it would tend to make the relations between the two countries better than they were before. England was determined that she was not going to be bluffed. A section of the French people were fond of taking liberties with the British nation, but such transactions would not pay.

Mr. Chamberlain, as Colonial Secretary, has taken steps to establish a School of Tropical Medicine at the Seamen's Hospital at the Albert Docks, and has issued an important circular to the Medical Schools inviting their co-operation.

The Rev. J. S. Moffat, formerly British Assistant Commissioner in Basutoland and Matabeleland, gave an address yesterday at a meeting held in the Westminster Palace Hotel at the instance of the Aborigines Protection Society. His theme was the war against the Langeberg Bechuanaes, the confiscation of their territory, the sending of them to West Colony, fifteen hundred miles from their own country, and the indenturing of them to Dutch farmers. The conduct of the Cape Government in this affair was, he contended, illegal, and he trusted that public opinion in this country would be directed to the question.

Mr. Justice Barnes and a special jury yesterday finally disposed of the Mathews Divorce case. After deliberating for an hour, the jury found that the charges of misconduct had not been proved, and both petitions were dismissed.

Tom Turner, the feather-weight boxer, who was injured at the National Sporting Club on Monday night in a contest with Nat Smith, and had afterwards remained unconscious, died in Charing-cross Hospital yesterday afternoon. Late in the day seven persons who were directly or indirectly concerned with the competition were brought before a magistrate on the charge of being concerned in Turner's manslaughter. Defendants were remanded on their own recognisances of 50l. each.

After a hearing which has, at weekly intervals, occupied the magistrate since the 17th of September, H. Davies, private surgeon, of Castlenau-gardens, Barnes, was yesterday committed for trial on charges of forgery and fraud in the connection with alleged discoveries as to the pedigree of Lieutenant-Col. Shipway.

Mr. R. B. Marshall opened an inquiry yesterday, at the Guildhall, Westminster, on behalf of the Board of Trade, into the circumstances attending the loss of the steamship Mohegan, and 106 lives, on the Manacles rocks, off the Cornish coast, on the 14th of October last. Some witnesses were called, but the most important matters had not been reached when the Court adjourned until to-day.

A verdict of manslaughter was yesterday returned by a Coroner's jury against the man accused of pushing a boy over Southwark Bridge on Guy Fawkes Day.
