1890.

We continue today the statistics, etc., relating to the past year, acknowledging as before our indebtedness to the Siglo for most of the data.

Posts. In the first nine months of the year the number of letters, papers, cards, packets, etc. amounted to 16,139,898.

Railways and Telegraphs. According to the map published by the Inspector General, Sr. Lanza, early in 1889, the following was the railway kilometrage in the Republic.

This bears out our statement that the railway building had progressed steadily despite the crisis, there being opened to public service during the year 677.60 kilometres, or about 420 miles, of new line.

The following table shows the head of cattle slaughtered in the Oriental and Argentine Republics, for the last ten years.

Registry of Sales

In 1889, thanks to the inflated speculation in land, the value of landed property sold, according to the official register was \$63,546,624. of which some \$45,500,000, belonged to the department of Montevideo.

This table (says the Siglo) does not include \$4,200,000 of Treasury Bonds emitted to cover part of the deficit left by the administrations of Santos and Tajas, in 1889.

Population. What the Siglo terms the "vegetable" movement of the population of the Republic is far from satisfactory, as may be seen from the following table.

This is a much more satisfactory subject. The following table gives the number of public schools and scholars of both sexes, throughout the Republic, for five years, according to figures furnished by the National Inspector of Public Instruction.

The average attendance rose from 22,353 in 1889 to 27,557 in 1890. Of the 36,215 scholars registered in 1890, 20,349 were boys and 15,866 were girls; 23,057 belong to the department of Montevideo and 23,158 to the rest of the Republic.

Consumption of Meat. Even this item shows signs of the crisis. The following are the statistics of the meat consumed in Montevideo in the last two years.
