BUENOS AIRES.

The Government Engineer of the Port Works, Sr. Stavellius, reports that \$15,981,200 has been expended out of the \$20,000,000 gold authorized by the law of 27th October 1889, and that a further sum of \$17,820,360 gold will be required for completing the works, exclusive of the dry docks, the construction of which has not been decreed.

The Council of Public Works has therefore submitted to the Government a proposal for the application of the balance available, giving preference to the North Basin and to the dredging on that side, and using any surplus in completing the railways on the wharfs and in the excavation of Dock No. 3, but suspending the masonry work in that dock.

The National Bank will remove to its new premises during Holy Week. The office for changing of notes will be at the corner of Rivadavia and Reconquista, the entrance to the savings department will be in calle Rivadavia.

The Metropolitan Tramway line stations, houses, cars, horses, etc. is again announced for sale by public auction by order of the Courts, on the 15th of March.

La Plata-The managers of the Railways in the province have refused to reduce their rates for carrying cereals, etc., on the grounds that they are passing through a very difficult financial period and that the Frequentation has no right to intervene in fixing the tariffs, because the lines are not yet making 10 per cent profit.

The Chamber of Deputies has sanctioned the articles of the Electoral law.

The President of the Senate, Sr. Victor del Carril, has appointed his nephew as chief officer in the secretary's department, passing over old employes.

BARON HIRSCH AND THE JEWS.

It is now some time since Baron Hirsch announced his intention of devoting twelve millions of francs for the benefit of distressed Jewish families, especially those in Russia, Galicia, and the Bukovina. The plan adopted for the application of this magnificent sum of money was to acquire farming land, divide it into suitable allotments for families, supply the necessary stock, and make provision for initiating the prospective occupants in the mysteries of agriculture. It had been decided to make the first trial in Argentina, and the practical arrangements had been completed for giving effect to the beneficent scheme, when news was received which induced the managers to make further inquiry before carrying out their plan. It appears that the experience of Jewish emigrants already settled in that district of South America has been far from agreeable. They suffer a great deal from persecution, and many of them are in quite as deep distress as they were before leaving the old country. It has been determined, therefore, to send out a commission of inquiry, and until its report has been received poor Jews are warned not to seek a home or settlement in Argentina.

National Bank shares opened 29, but that figure was not maintained, and after a considerable amount of oscillation they closed with a falling tendency at 25 1/2 for Monday, 28 for next Saturday, 6210 sold.

Other sales were, \$66,000 Cédulas A at 44 1/2 cash, 45 end of month. \$6,500 Cédulas B at 42 and 41 cash. \$90,000 Amortizables at 33 to 33 1/2 cash, 33 1/2 and 34 end of March.

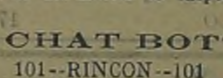
