A horrible case of prolonged cruelty to a child came to light yesterday, the victim being an orphan girl named Guillermina Tossi y Quiros, aged only about 7 years. She had fallen into the clutches of a harpy named Rosa Nuñez, living at Cerro 243, who in concert with an old man named Juan Fedriol and another named Juan Salguero, subjected her to the most abominable and cruel treatment, the details of which it is not possible even to hint at.

A man named Meliton Cuello, condemned to 8 years imprisonment in 1876 for a murder, and in 1884 to a similar term for a second murder committed almost immediately on the expiration of his first sentence, was released from prison on Friday, his term having expired. He was met, it is related, by a group of some twenty friends, who gave him a warm welcome.

Sr. Rafael Ellauri, appointed a day or two ago as commissary of the 7th Section (Cerro) was arrested yesterday by superior order. The causes are not yet known. Several changes in the sectional commissaries are being made, in pursuance of the efforts of the new Chief of Police to improve the service.

LONDON NOTES

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 13.

In the House of Lords, yesterday, Viscount Midleton asked if the Government would issue a Royal Commission on the subject of fog in London.

In the Commons, Mr. J. Redmond's amendment to the Address, calling for reconsideration of the cases of Irish prisoners convicted under the Treason Felony Act, was further discussed.

The fourth of the series of Liberal and Radical demonstrations held in view of the approaching general election, took place last night in the Holloway Hall, under the presidency of Mr. Thos. Lough.

ing at Portsmouth last night, in support of the policy of Home Rule for Ireland. He claimed that the principles of Home Rule were well understood, and deprecated any statement of details merely to satisfy the demands of opponents.

The London coal porters' strike is at an end. It has been agreed that the men shall return to work this morning for all firms except Messrs. Cameron, whose disagreement with their employees led to the difficulty.

The supply of meat at Smithfield yesterday was shorter than usual on a Friday. It is still thought, however, that prices will go up, unless the orders of the Board of Agriculture are continued for a length of time.

A Bernese Correspondent states that the Federal Government, in consequence of the failure in the treaty negotiations with Italy, has decided to apply the General Customs Tariff to all goods of Italian origin.

There was a large attendance at Kempton Park February Hunt Meeting yesterday. The Hurdle Handicap was secured by Prince Frederick, the Littleton Steeplechase by Spring-bank, the Surbiton Handicap by Dunbridge.

The Greenich burglary case was dealt with at the Central Criminal Court, when three men were indicted at the instance of the South Eastern Railway Company, for maliciously assaulting Police-constables Smeeth and Tappin at Maze-hill.

At the Central Criminal Court two young men, Arthur Hercomb and John Biron, against whom previous convictions were proved, were sentenced to three years penal servitude each, for stealing a gold watch, for which they had been in custody.

Interest in the case of Mr. Osborne showed no sign of diminution yesterday when evidence was taken at Bow street, before Sir John Bridge, in support of the charge of perjury.

At the outset, transcripts of statements made by Mrs Osborne at the recent trial denying that she ever endorsed a cheque for 550l. drawn by Messrs. Spink, or had ever been concerned in certain monetary transactions, were put in by the prosecution.

Sentence was passed by Sir John Bridge, at Bow-street, on the men charged with keeping the Courts Club, Strand, as a common gaming-house, or with being found on the premises. One man, Costerton, was committed for two months; another, Linz, was fined 50l.

Although in many instances work was resumed by the coal porters on Saturday at the various London depots, matters proceeded anything but smoothly during the day.

The Salvation Army demonstration in Hyde-park on Saturday, with a review by General Booth, and his return from abroad, proved a distinct success. Those who took part in it had been exceptionally well organized, and the orders being punctiliously carried out, the result was most gratifying.

A Rome Correspondent telegraphs that the Pope has been deeply grieved by the death of Mr. Bocchi, his confidant, and his health has suffered so that he has had to give up granting audiences for the present.

Saturday's football embraced many matches of note. Associationists concentrated their attention on the English Cup ties (four in number), and vast crowds witnessed the play at the different grounds.

Mr. Justice Denman and a special jury had before them the action of Plato and wife v. Toy, in which the plaintiffs claimed damages from the landlord of some model dwellings, alleging that in consequence of the insanitary condition of the tenement they occupied at Bethnal-green four of their children had died from diphtheria and that they themselves had been ill.
