—The seal of the Executive has been put to the Bill for the protection of vine-culture, which is now Law.

—On Friday evening, a violent quarrel, arising from an accusation of foul play, arose between two of the ball-players engaged at the Fronton Jai Alai in calle 18 de Julio, named Mendaró and Lizarraga.

BUENOS AIRES —On Tuesday the Supreme Court decided that the persons sent to Montevideo by order of the President of the Republic may return to this country, without prejudice to the President's powers during the state of siege.

—The National Government has approved the plans for the projected branches of the San Cristobal and Tucuman line to La Banda and Cruz Alta.

—The National College has been closed for eight days owing to the rioting of the students, and the trouble between the new Rector and the old masters, who have all resigned.

—All the ships of the squadron are to be ready to leave on May 15th for a cruise of three months to the South coast.

—The total quantity of land sown with wheat and flax last year in Santa Fé and the Union department of the province of Córdoba, was about 560,000 hectáreas.

—Demand for the Bion "Crab Apple Blossoms" has been so brisk that stock has run out for the moment.

LONDON NOTES

TUESDAY, MARCH 29. In the House of Lords, yesterday, the Marquis of Salisbury said, in answer to Lord Herschell, who had given notice of a question before the publication of the correspondence on the subject of the Behring Sea Fisheries dispute.

In the Commons several questions were asked with regard to the wearing of the shamrock on St. Patrick's Day by Irishmen in the army and navy.

the amendment was withdrawn and the Bill read a second time. Mr. Alderman Barker gave evidence before a Committee of the House of Commons yesterday in favour of the curtailment of the hours of labour in shops.

Under the presidency of Mr. Plunket, First Commissioner of Works, the Select Committee of the House of Commons appointed to inquire into the licensing laws affecting theatres and other places of amusement held their first meeting yesterday, when Mr. Fardell, chairman of the Theatre Committee of the first London County Council, was examined in regard to the Theatre Bill promoted by that body in 1891.

The "Hargreave jewels," consisting of a pair of top and drop brilliant earrings, and three pearl pendants (one of which was not among those sold to Messrs. Spiak), were disposed of in two lots by Messrs. Christie yesterday. They realised together the sum of 1,076l.

Sir Henry Drummond Wolff, the newly-appointed British Ambassador to Spain, was received by Queen Christina in Madrid yesterday, the function being attended by great ceremony. Court mourning was suspended for the occasion, and the scene at the reception was one of exceptional brilliance.

A graphic description of the scene of the supposed anarchist outrage in Paris is given. The agent used in the explosion remain a matter of conjecture. In the Chamber yesterday "urgency" was voted for the discussion of a Bill to inflict the extreme penalty of the law upon the perpetrators of outrages upon property by means of explosions.

It is believed, says a New York Correspondent, that the Free Coinage Bill was practically disposed of yesterday, when thirty-five Democratic members of Congress, former supporters of the Bill, refused to sign a petition to the Speaker in its favour.

The third match between Lord Sheffield's team and an Eleven of Combined Australia terminated yesterday in a victory for the Englishmen by an innings and 230 runs. The inquest on the body of Mrs. Frederick Bailey Deeming and her four children, recently found buried in cement in Dinham Villa, Rainhill, was resumed yesterday. Among the witnesses was Mrs. Albert Deeming sister of the deceased woman, who deposed to conversations she had with Frederick Deeming, now under arrest in Australia, as to the whereabouts of her sister and the children.

The House of Lords dealt yesterday with the case of Concha (pauper) v. Concha and wife, which has been the subject of litigation during the last thirty-four years. The dispute had reference to property left by the appellant father, and the question to be determined now was whether the judgment of the Court of Appeal, varying certain orders made by Mr. Justice Stirling, should be upheld. The Court thought the orders should be varied, but postponed final judgment that the parties might endeavour to agree upon a form of certificate.

A singular case of mistaken identity on the part of the police was heard by the Highgate magistrates. Three constables swore that a horse dealer was guilty of furious driving at Wheatstone on the night of Sunday, February 29, while the defendant adduced overwhelming evidence to show that he was in Suffolk at the time. The summons was dismissed, but without costs.
