

In that of Caseros great numbers of hoppers threaten the maize. In Villa Constitution the flax crop yields over 30 %, whilst the maize needs rain and is threatened by the hoppers. There is quite a little trouble among the threshing machine men. He consid-ers the harvest assured, quality of grain excellent, and the far-mers in general very grateful for the activity displayed in exterminating the plague, many having expressed the opinion that in order to make the campaign a permanent one it would be ad-visable to levy a tax of 10 cents on every quintal of grain, which seems an excellent idea as calculating the wheat crop at 1,500,000 tons the wheat crop at 1,500,000 tors the tax would thus give 11/4 million dollars, without any undue strain on the farmers. We believe the Finance Minister has mooted the advisability, in the same train of ideas, of a dollar on every hectare cultivated, but this might happen to press unduly on people suffering from the plague, whilst the tax on return of grain would not, since all would pay in just proportion. The levying of the tax would seem to offer some difficulties, but this could be studied, and difficulties obviated. Anyway it is a practical point that well merits consideration of the Government and Congress .- B. A Standard.


