Prince Nicholas of Montenegro reached London on Saturday. He was received at Charing Cross by the Duke of York. Yesterday his Highness went to Windsor on a visit to the Queen whose guest he is expected to remain for a few days.

Lady Edward Spencer Churchill distributed the prizes in connection with the annual essay competition of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals at the Crystal Palace on Saturday, when there was a very large gathering of school children.

The sale of the great Ashburnham library came to a close on Saturday at Sotheby's. Twenty days were occupied in disposing of the four thousand lots, the total realised being £2,712.

Lifeboat Saturday was observed in London on Saturday.

Thousands of persons visited the Alexandra Palace on Saturday to witness the first display of Messrs James Pain and Sons' great spectacle 'The Destruction of Pompeii.' The dramatic incidents were well sustained.

Less than an hour's cricket on Saturday sufficed to bring the match between the M. C. C. and Yorkshire to a close. On a wicket damaged by rain the M. C. C. only added 24 to their overnight score, and in the end were defeated by 99 runs.

Judgment was delivered on Saturday in the Queen's Bench Division by a special Court, presided over by the Lord Chief Justice, in a case in which the powers of a County Council—in this instance the Banstead Council—to pass a by-law generally forbidding music and singing in the streets, was called in question.

visional Court pronounced in favour of the reasonableness of permitting representative bodies to regulate their own affairs, the Lord Chief Justice stating that in such matters local bodies might be trusted to understand their own requirements better than the judges. The conviction was affirmed, and the appeal dismissed.

A suit brought by Mr. Brandon Thomas, the author of the well-known play 'Charley's Aunt,' against Mr. Penley, the actor, for an account of profits alleged to have been made by the latter in disposing of the right of producing the play in America and Canada, came before Mr Justice Romer in the Chancery Division on Saturday. It was stated that plaintiff had received about 6,000l., and the defendant nearly double that amount for the performances in America. Plaintiff claimed that he was entitled to a greater proportion of the profits. The hearing was adjourned.

"I told you I should ask that question again, Sydney, I am asking it now. Will you give me the place in your heart—the love, the privileges that you once gave to Bernard Ansell?"

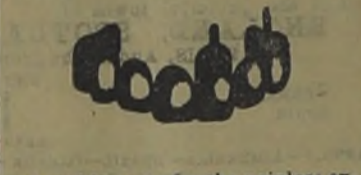
