WEDNESDAY, MAY 11. A Correspondent in Milan telegraphs briefly saying that in consequence of a yet more rigid censorship of telegrams he is unable to send further accounts of the revolutionary events there.

"Sydney! You heard—you caught something of what I said to Joan?" "I heard every word."

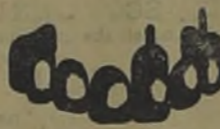
