LONDON NOTES

WEDNESDAY, MAY 25. According to the latest arrangements made by the Duke of Norfolk, Earl Marshal, the funeral of Mr. Gladstone will take place in Westminster Abbey at 10.45 on Saturday morning.

A Correspondent at Hawarden describes the solemn scene within the 'Temple of Peace' yesterday, where the body of the deceased statesman lay in the simple majesty of death, clothed in the scarlet robes of an Oxford doctor.

There would appear to be little doubt that the coffin will be conveyed to night direct to Westminster by train, the route being by way of Willesden, Addison road, and the District Railway.

Resolutions of condolence continue to be passed by public bodies throughout the country. Regret was yesterday so expressed by the cities of Dublin and Edinburgh; and at the National Liberal Club, before the commencement of the business of the annual meeting, sympathetic references were made by Earl Carrington and Mr. Labouchere, M. P., on behalf of the members.

At yesterday's meeting of the London County Council, after a tribute to the memory of Mr. Gladstone by the chairman, it was decided to raise the salary of Mr. Howard, the Comptroller, from 1,000l. to 1,250l.

Troops embarked yesterday at San Francisco on board the City of Sydney and Australia for the Philippine Islands.

A letter has been published in Rome from the Pope to Cardinal Ferrari, Archbishop of Milan, upon the recent troubles in that city. The Pontiff declares these to be the outcome of the alienation of the nation from the Church and from God.

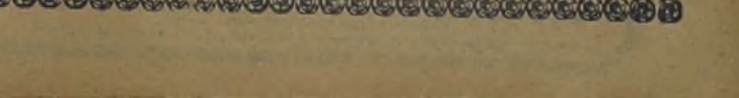

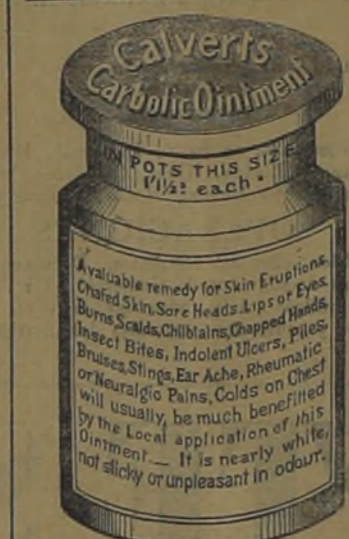
