—It may surprise old amusement lovers to learn that one of the original troupes of Christy Minstrels which came over to England in 1845 (three years after the entertainment was first started in a Buffalo tavern) is still alive, and has recently reappeared before the public. Mr. William A. Porter is now 73, and early in the present month he took part in an amateur minstrel entertainment for a charitable purpose at Johannesburg, Penn., U. S., playing a violin solo and singing a base song. Mr. Porter was the original tambourine of the troupe, both in London and afterwards on the Australian tour, and in accordance with the custom of the period he then sang both serious and comic songs and played the fiddle. In those days, of course, the songs were real plantation melodies and the jokes genuine negro fun; but the entertainment in the course of years has become very much changed.

—We quote from the B. A. Standard of Wednesday.—Yesterday the Recoleta bells tolled their funeral knell over the coffin of one of the most charitable and best known Hiberno-Portefino ladies in this city—Mrs. Galbraith. For the last 40 years this distinguished lady played her part in this community more as a sister of charity than a member of the high life society in which she figured. We may safely say that there is not a charitable or religious institution in Buenos Aires that does not owe something to Mrs. Galbraith, and her loss will long be felt not only by the poor of whom she was the patroness, but also by the nuns, who owe so much of their success in this country to her valued and continued services. Mrs. Galbraith was the daughter of Mr. Patrick Bookley, who came to this country some 70 years ago, made a fortune, bought the beautiful property Santa Catalina, built a large wing at his own expense of the Irish convent in Calle Rio Bamba, reared a large family, and, ripe in years, passed to another and better world. The name of Bookley is indelibly engraved in the early Irish history of this country, as he was always a steady friend and adviser to his struggling countrymen in those struggling years. His eldest daughter, the subject of this notice, married in her turn and was remarkable for her great beauty. Her husband, Mr. Galbraith, was at that period one of the most fashionable men in town, and shortly after his marriage he retired to his estancia in Entre Rios, where he died very early in life, leaving two daughters and one son, who is the Federal Judge in Rosario, and the eldest daughter inheriting the deep religious sentiments of her mother, entered the Sacred Heart Convent some years ago. Mrs. Galbraith always moved in the very first circles of native society and always figured in those benevolent societies administered by the ladies of Buenos Aires which so embellish our community. Some few months ago she returned from her estancia in Entre Rios in very poor health, but she recovered and became apparently quite strong again; her death, therefore, comes as a very sudden surprise to all her friends, and, as we lay a wreath over her grave, we express to her sorrowing family our deepest sympathy at their irreparable loss.

LONDON NOTES

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 8.

A dispatch from Sir A. Biliotti, British Consul in Crete, has been received giving an account of the outbreak at Candia. The British Vice-Consul was burned in his house. A party of 20 bluejackets from H. M. S. Hazard were nearly annihilated, and the total casualties are about 20 killed and 50 wounded.

The Sirdar estimates the Dervish losses at Omdurman as follows: 10,800 killed in the battle, about 16,000 wounded, 300 to 400 killed in the streets of the city, and three to four thousand taken prisoners. The Earl of Winchelsea died at Haverholme Priory, Seaford, yesterday evening after a long illness.

Sir William Crookes yesterday opened the third meeting of the British Association at Bristol, with his Presidential address. He devoted a large part of his discourse to a consideration of the danger which, he thought, would threaten the wheat consuming populations of the world in the near future from an insufficient supply of the cereal; and came to the conclusion that from increase of population and other causes the limits of the expansion of its production would be reached in the year 1931.

A vigorous reply has been sent by the Shoreditch Vestry to the Local Government Board repudiating the suggestions made by that body as to a waste of water in the district, and placing the whole responsibility for the present state of affairs in the East End upon the East London Water Company. They also state that local public opinion is beginning to have «very considerable doubts as to the disinterestedness or intelligence of the Government in their dealings with this matter»

Manoeuvres in Wiltshire yesterday were continued by another «fight» between the Northern and Southern armies, although it had been intended that the day should be devoted to rest. The heavy work and the hot sun were very trying to the men, whose distress was even greater than on previous days.

Cricket at Hastings yesterday went all in favour of Mr. Stoddart's team, who beat their opponents, the Rest of England, by five wickets.

For using a publichouse for the purposes of betting, a bookmaker named George Robinson was, at the Marylebone Police Court yesterday, fined 400l. and 21l. costs with the alternative of thirteen months imprisonment. Arthur Pullen, landlord of the Wallace Head Blandford-street, the licensed house in question, was penalised to the extent of 75l. for allowing the premises to be so used.

Some remarkable evidence was given at Reading Police Court yesterday when the charges against the two men, Ward and Smith, of having been concerned in the Ascot burglary were further gone into; a constable detailing a singular conversation he deposed to having heard between the prisoners while he was concealed in a cell near them at the police station. The accused were committed for trial.
