On Thursday last, at Hull, the third class cruiser "Prometheus" was launched successfully. The vessel has entered the water with all its machinery already fitted. The new cruiser is a ship of 2135 tons displacement and of 7000 nominal horse power.

—The remains of the late Mr. Edward Hamilton Gowland, who died some four years ago in the Province of Cordoba Argentine Republic, arrived from Buenos Aires on Sunday morning by the steamer "Montevideo," and were at once deposited in the Gowland family vault in the British Cemetery in this city.

While the Dreyfus case is once more filling so large a place in the public eye, and the first step has been taken towards a revision of the trial, it is not without interest to remember that at the time he was degraded he declared, "in three years the truth will be known."

Arthur MacMurrough Kavanagh, who was for more than a decade the leader of the Irish Landlord Party in the House of Commons.

A telegram from Shanghai states that the Emperor's adviser who fled from Peking last week has reached there and taken refuge on board the British gunboat Esk.

The Baptist Autumnal Assembly begins today at Nottingham, and a large attendance is expected. Dr. Booth, who has retired from the secretaryship though his name still appears as acting secretary, has been forbidden by his medical attendant to be present.

There were large crowds at nearly all the big League football matches on Saturday, and those at Liverpool and Birmingham were estimated at over 80,000.

A bargeman named Henry Crampion was charged at Stratford Police-court on Saturday with wilfully murdering James Neal, by stabbing him at Barking, on Friday night. The prisoner did not deny the offence, but stated that he had used his knife in self defence.
