UNEMPLOYMENT

By André Siegfried (Continued)

The most dangerous and the most subtle element of paid nnemployment is the slow breaknig down of the will to work. In certain cases it actually pays better to be idle, for the worldman is bet ter off. Taking everything account, a man can often receiv more from the dole and the Guar dians than from working normal at his trade. According to the re port of the Assistant-General In spector of the Ministry of Health the following scandalous cases are

Fnally, all effort, aptitude. and energy are benumbed.

The life of the nation goes none the less, with a tranquillity and regularity that is most deceptive. The Government seems to fear this great body of idle men. and does what is urgent; it supports them, making sure that they remain calm, and are not driven to desperation. Foreign may argue that a policy of laissez. faire would soon put England on her feet again. This is the way they talk when they are outside the country.
